SYDENHAM HOCKEY CLUB

At the fourth annual meeting of the Sydenham Hockey Club, held in the Druids' Hall, Sydenham the President (Mr H N Bates) occupied the chair, and there was a large attendance. Correspondence was read from the Waimate and Timaru Hockey Clubs with reference to the annual match, and it was decided that the games should be played at Sydenham Park on Easter Monday. The annual report showed that the club had been represented by six teams in the four competitions held last season and that all six had done well. The Borough Council wrote granting the use of two grounds at Sydenham Park. The Treasurer reported a credit balance of 21. The following officers were elected: President, Mr H. N.
